Club K

Children entering Kindergarten may take part in our Club K program. This program runs in conjunction with Club Care, but also focuses on preparing these students for kindergarten in the fall. Club K takes separate, age appropriate fieldtrips in the beginning of summer. Club K is offered at all three sites.

Each site is staffed by degreed professionals who are assisted by skilled assistants and aides. Summer Club Care

To ensure a spot in the Summer Club Care program, your registration must be submitted on or before 4:00 pm on **Thursday, April 8th, 2010**. Registration is contingent on space, so please register early.

Nature Camp Week

Club Care will be offering a Nature Camp week from August 23rd-27th, 2010. We will be providing additional information about this camp in the program packets you will receive after registration. Nature Camp registration is optional and separate from the Summer Club Care program.



Field Trips & T-shirts

Club Care will go on two field trips each week. Field trips will take place on Tuesdays and Thursdays at all sites this summer. There is no additional charge for these trips. Club Care will provide each child with a t-shirt to be worn on field trip days. Additional shirts may be purchased for \$8.00 at the time of registration.

T-shirt sizes: Youth small (6-8), Youth medium(10-12), Youth large (14-16), Adult small, medium and large.

Meals

A light breakfast and an afternoon snack are provided daily. A healthy lunch program is also available. You have the option to purchase the lunch program or provide a cold lunch and beverage each day. If you choose to purchase the lunch program, it must be purchased for each day your child is registered for Club Care. The lunch option includes a mix of hot and cold lunches each week. Payments for the lunch program will be split into three equal payments and added to your monthly statements. Prices are:

5 days per week	\$40/month
4 days per week	\$32/month
3 days per week	\$24/month
2 days per week	\$16/month
1 day per week	\$8/month

Club Care Swimming Lessons

Swimming lessons are available to Club Care participants. Lessons take place Monday & Wednesday afternoons beginning July 6th and running through 29th. We will be offering Red Cross levels 2-4. Lessons are taught by our certified aquatics staff and supervised by trained lifeguards. The cost per child will be \$55 for the lessons plus a \$20 transportation fee to the Chaska Middle School East pool. Payment will be billed at time of registration. Vacation Time

Vacation days are allotted based on the number of days per week you are registered. If you are registered 5 days per week, you will receive 5 vacation days, 4 days per week and you will receive 4 vacation days, etc. Once the allotted days have been used, payment is required for any additional absences.

To complete your summer Club Care registration, simply complete the contract, make a copy for your records, and return it with a \$100 deposit to **your Club Care site** or to the **Community Education office at 11 Peavey Road, Chaska MN, 55318**. All registrations must include the \$100 deposit in order to be processed. The deposit is non-refundable but will be applied to your June program fee statement.

Next Step: Middle School

Blaze Camp is available and designed as a full day summer experience for young people entering 6th-8th grade. Those entering 6th grade are free to choose between Club Care and Blaze Camp in terms of the best programming to meet individual and family needs. Blaze Camp will include similar activities, trips and events all designed with middle-school in mind. Blaze Camp will be held Monday-Friday, from 7:00 am – 5:30 pm at Middle School West.

- Tuition is due monthly on the following dates: Wednesday, June 16; Thursday, July 15; Monday, August 16.

- Late payment fees will apply to accounts not paid in full by above dates.

- Past-due accounts may be sent to a collection agency.

- Late pick-up fees apply when children are picked up after 6p.m.

- Enrolling in summer Club Care does not guarantee placement in the 2010-2011 school year program.
